

## Robert JAMESON

## Memorial 89

Robert JAMESON died in May 1809 at Heavitree, Exeter. He was buried at the Dissenters' Graveyard on Thursday, 18 May 1809<sup>1</sup>. The Accounts Book reads "May 07 Breaking ground for R Jameson 8s".<sup>2</sup>

The Monthly Magazine Vol 27, Page 635 shows "At Heavitree, Mr Robert Jameson, son of John.J esq. of Aberdeen, 27".<sup>3</sup>

There is no information in the record of Inscriptions 1894m not 1984. The Memorial Stone examined in 2014 shows no name but has a date of death/burial attached later to Robert Jameson.<sup>4</sup>

Research indicates that Robert may have been the son of John Jameson and Isabel Smith and that, if so, he was baptized in the church of St. Nicholas, Aberdeen, Scotland on 18 January 1783.<sup>5</sup> John and Isabel married on 29 August 1779 at the church of St Nicholas, Aberdeen.<sup>6</sup>

No other information can be found at this point.
