CAROLINE BIELFELD (written 2nd May 1838)

This is the last Will and Testament of me Caroline Bielfeld of Heavitree in the County of Devon Spinster I give devise and bequeath all my freehold real copyhold and leasehold messuages tenements dwelling houses lands hereditaments and premises and parts and shares of freehold real copyhold and leasehold messuages tenements dwelling houses lands hereditaments and premises with their respective rights members and appurtenances whether situate in the several parishes of Harpford Venn Ottery otherwise ffen Ottery and in Heavitree in the said County of Devon or in any or either of the said parishes or elsewhere in England and whether in possession reversion vested or contingent unto my dear sister Anna Henrietta Bielfeld her heirs executors administrators and assigns for ever or according to the quality of the estate for her and their own absolute use and benefit also I give and bequeath all my stock in the public funds monies and securities for money goods chattels wearing apparel and all other my personal and testamentary estate effects and property whatsoever and wheresoever unto my said sister Anna Henrietta Bielfeld to and for her own benefit absolutely subject nevertheless to the payment of my just debts funeral expenses and the charges of proving this my will and I appoint my said dear sister Anna Henrietta Bielfeld sole executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made In witness whereof I the said Caroline Bielfeld the testatrix have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this second day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight Caroline Bielfeld ----- signed sealed published and declared by the said Caroline Bielfeld the testatrix as and for her last will and testament in the presence of us who at her request in her presence and in the presence of each other hereunto subscribed our names as witness thereto Joseph Mountford of Exeter sol. Gabriel Vrignon Thomas Turner his clerks.

Proved at London 15th January 1846 before the judge by the oath of **Anna Henrietta Bielfeld spinster** the sister the sole executrix to whom admon was granted having been first sworn by common duly to administer.
