### **HENRY BIELFELD (written 18<sup>th</sup> July 1783)**

This is the Last will and testament of me **Henry Bielfield** of the City of Exeter, **Merchant**. I give to my servant who shall be a living with me at my death ten pounds to be paid immediately after my death, also all the rest, residue and remainder of my goods, chattels, rights, credits, personal and testamentary estate and effects whatsoever and wheresover subject to the payment of my just debts I hereby give and bequeath unto my **nephew Diederick Arnold Bielfield son of my brother Hermann Bielfield** to and for his own use benefit and disposal, lastly I do make and appoint my said nephew **Diederick Arnold Bielfield** executor of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the eighteenth day of July in the year of our lord **one thousand seven hundred and eighty three** ...*Henry Bielfield* signed, sealed published and declared by the above named Henry Bielfield as and for this last will and testament in the presence of us **Ann Sanford, William Sanford**.

This will was proved at London the fourth day of January in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six before the Right Honourable Sir William Wyatt(?) Knight also Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the prerogative the Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oath of **Diederick Arnold Bielfield** the nephew of the deceased and sole executor named in the said will to whom administration was granted of all and singular goods chattels and credits of the said deceased having both first sworn by commission duly to administer.
